OUR CLUB HISTORY

Founded in 1946, the Norwood Basketball Club's origins can be traced back to Moresby in 1943.

The club was formed from returned servicemen of the 2/10th Battalion from World War II.

The principal sport of the American Soldiers was basketball, and it did not take long for others to see their enjoyment. Basketball was played by the 2/10" unit at Moresby, but it was at Kairi in 1944 and 1945 where close to every member of the Battalion became imbued with the idea that basketball was a great game. Companies & platoons formed teams, and challenges were thrown out in all directions. The unit side, skippered by Bluey Clarke, quickly developed into a first-class combination, and had some great tussles with teams from other units. Most of the games were played outdoors. When the weather became wet it was discovered that the huge amenity halls were ideal for basketball.

Since inception, Norwood have produced a long and successful history as one of South Australia's leading sporting clubs; with a reputation as a centre of excellence for young basketballers.

Red and blue wearing juniors have, over the years, gone on to play for American Colleges, State & National League teams, with an elite few going on to represent Australia on the Olympic and international stage.

Norwood Basketball Club offers children the opportunity to play basketball at many different levels.

- Domestic league (ACBA): 6 year-olds + getting the chance to experience the game in an organised way for the first time
- Junior District basketball: Under 10 to Under 23 age groups
- Men's or Women's Senior programs: NBL1 is the state league, flagship team of the club which field both Women & Men's sides in the highly competitive NBL1 Central Conference.

Our basketball coaching and development programs also spread far and wide in the inner eastern suburbs. We interact and support several High School programs in our catchment area, as well as primary school teams, social teams and other sporting code clubs. We provide coaches to run programs, games and provide assistance to incumbents in school environments.

The Norwood Flames have been an integral part of Adelaide's eastern community for several generations and have touched the lives of many local families, with one time playing grandparents now enjoying their grandchildren's participation.

OUR HOME STADIUM

Norwood Basketball Club's home is at The ARC Campbelltown.

With 5 basketball courts (including two show courts), NBL1 games offer grandstand seating on both sides of the court as well as upstairs seating.

A seating capacity of approximately 800 and an enclosed upstairs bar overlooking the action ensures a fantastic view for every spectator.

The Coopers court side bar and DJ, make our home game experience second to none.

PROUD HERITAGE

Home & Away Uniform

Our current Home Blue? and Away White? uniforms are a mirror design effect. The inspiration for the uniforms partly came from the Phoenix Suns 'The Valley' uniformdepicting an Arizonian landscape.

The most iconic landmark in Norwood is the Town Hall. Since 1883, the town hall has adorned The Parade and as such, the Norwood area. Having a physical representation of our community helps strengthen the bonds, links and importance behind putting on the 'Norwood Red & Blue'. As a player, the symbolism is strong; you are representing our local community and all those within it.

The Town hall can be seen in red on our blue uniforms and in grey on our white uniforms.



ANZAC Uniform

At Norwood Basketball Club, we are very proud of our military heritage and honour it with our ANZAC uniforms, where we pay homage to the origins of our club, the 2/10th Battalion. Combining the army fatigues camo green with Norwood's navy and red, decorated with a red poppy and the 2/10th Battalions purple and blue insignia. The Adelaide Rifles uniform is something our players wear with pride and make the ANZAC games something special.

ANZAC Uniforms are only worn on ANZAC Day or ANZAC Round games. These games have full ANZAC fanfare- with a live band that plays war-time tunes, an ANZAC Spirit Medal for the most apt player and other ANZAC themed activities and games.



Meaning of Norwood's First Nations Uniform as explained by the Artist: Amy Walley-Stack Front of the Jersey top to bottom:

- Gum tree flowers & kangaroo grass.
- Norwood was a magnificent gum forest with an undergrowth of high kangaroo grass.
- Footprints & red dots represent Kondili and how the creator gave him the gift of fire.
- He put fire in Kondili feet and when he'd walk sparks would fly from his feet, when he danced great flames flew out from his feet.

Represents: Confidence and ability to grow and support as a team as well as dance with fire as they run down the court.

Back of the Jersey top to bottom:

- Crosshatch lines representing the pride & strong cultural connection the Ngarrindjeri people have to their land.
- The whale tail and spear representing Kondili and how he got his blowhole, one of the Ngarrindjeri peoples dreaming stories.

Represents: Strong & cultured connection.

Ribs of the Jersey:

The U IIU IU represents the supporters, families and coaching staff all there to cheer on their team!



SPONSORSHIP AND BRANDING EXPOSURE

Basketball is an Olympic sport and one of the fastest growing nationally, played 12 months of the year indoors, ensuring exposure to our supporters (potentially your customers) throughout the whole year. This includes a great captive audience market place via various marketing channels.

In 2024, Norwood had over 60 junior teams participating in District basketball, that equates to approximately 600 athletes having 2-4 interactions per week with our basketball operations. This does not include direct family members, extended family, friends and others who also participate in basketball from different roles; All of whom are accessible via our every growing social media presence (Facebook, Instagram, XPS and e-newsletters). We estimate this number to be upwards of 3,500 individuals per week who engage with Norwood Basketball Club.

We offer prospective sponsors a unique opportunity to be part of our future and the ongoing role we play in the local community, fostering local sport, whilst gaining valuable exposure to a loyal and continuously growing membership and supporter base.

Thousands of spectators attend our NBL1 home games across 9 home fixtures. We have also had a very successful introduction of our court side bar, and extra seating in 2024. All NBL1 games are live streamed with full commentary, and a Game of the Week aired on Kayo Freebies, making the reach to the public bigger than ever. We receive, on average, 2-4 Kayo games per season (+ finals).

Not only has our game day experience improved, but our social media is also going through a rapid transition as we try to maximise its potential. "Followers" of our Facebook page have increased markedly in the last 12 months, recently passing 4400 and they continue to rise, along with our fast-growing Instagram page that has rapidly reached 2900 followers. This means over seven thousand local people now get a notification every time we create a post, and they are seen by many more. Over the last 12 months we have averaged a combined reach of over 18000 people per month.

We are expecting these numbers to rise by the time the 2025 season comes around!!


